Subject: Syllabus Change

Effective immediately, Conservatory Canada has changed its policy on the Viva Voce requirement for Partial Examinations. In the past, students taking a Partial Examination had to include Viva Voce in the same part as the last List Pieces. Many teachers and students voiced their concerns regarding this policy and have stated that they would prefer to have the questions asked during the Partial in which the list pieces are performed. Since Conservatory Canada values the opinions of its teachers and students, this policy has been changed accordingly.

From now on, students taking Partial Examinations must answer verbal questions on the List Pieces in the same part as they are performed. For example, if a student performs their List A and List B selections during their first Partial Examination, they will be required answer verbal questions on these selections at this time. The remainder of the list pieces and verbal questions are to be included in their subsequent examination.

If a student has already completed a Partial Examination containing List Pieces and have not completed their Viva Voce requirement, they will be required to complete their examination as per the old policy.
